Juliette Low: A Badge of Honor

Introduction

You will have the opportunity to explore Juliette Low's life, her special qualities and achievements, and to learn about the Girl Scouts, which she started. After you gather information, you will compare Juliette's qualities and talents to your own and then will create badges to represent two of your best qualities, talents, or achievements.

Process

Step 1

You will need a journal or other notebook to take notes as you go to each Web site.

Step 2

Visit each of the Web sites listed below and make notes of Juliette Low's special qualities, talents, or achievements.

Step 5

Select two items from the list that you made for yourself and illustrate a symbol or scene to represent each one.
